UAE-UK Energy Transition Summit

The UAE-UK Business Council will be hosting a Summit aimed at identifying opportunities for collaboration between the two countries in the energy transition sector. The event will take place alongside the Energy Industries Council's Energy Exports Conference, taking place in Aberdeen on June 14-15. Delegates will therefore be able to register for and participate in both events on consecutive days.

Taking place midway between CoP26 and CoP28, the Summit will focus on three key issues – what needs to be done over the next five years in order to sustain progress towards Net Zero; reskilling the workforce in preparation for the energy transition; and financing the energy transition. Each Panel Discussion will feature speakers from both the UAE and the UK.

Hosted by Lord Udney-Lister, UK Co-Chair of the UAE-UK Business Council, we will be inviting Ministers and other senior dignitaries to the event, at which we anticipate an audience of around 150 senior decision-makers from across the industry.
