"Civil Marriage"

What is a Civil Marriage?

A civil marriage is a marriage which is conducted and registered in accordance with the relevant laws and regulations irrespective of any religious law.

> How much does it cost?

The civil marriage application fee is 300 AED.

What are the procedural steps?

- 1. Select the following link and select interactive case registration (ICR) (https://www.adjd.gov.ae/EN/Pages/nonmuslimsfamilycourt.aspx)
- 2. Complete and submit the application
- 3. Pay the fee (300 AED)
- 4. You will receive an email or telephone call within the next two working days to arrange the marriage ceremony appointment
- 5. Attend the Civil Family Court (ADJD main court building next to Zayed Sports City) and enter through Gate 5
- 6. Attend the ceremony and receive the marriage certificate.

> When can a marriage ceremony take place?

Marriage ceremonies can take place as follows:

Monday- 9:00am-1:30pm

Tuesday- 9:00am-1:30pm

Wednesday- 9:00am-1:30pm

Thursday- 9:00am-1:30pm

Friday- 9:00am-11:00am

When the civil marriage application has been received, you will receive an email or telephone call from the Court to arrange an appointment for the ceremony. The court will do their best to accommodate you subject to the availability of appointments.
